PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS



Students must be an active member in good standing with the Travis FFA in order to participate on any team or contest. This includes: Raising Livestock, competing at Jr. FFA events and the end of the year FFA Trip

In order to be in good standing you must complete the following requirements:

- In 3rd – 8th grade and **zoned** to attend Travis High School
- At least 30% attendance at FFA Meetings. (**2 of the following:** Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, April meetings.. October and February meetings are at 2:50pm and junior ffa will not be able to attend)
- Attend the **FFA Banquet in May**
- Be passing all classes by UIL standard and adhere to all UIL conduct policies.
- Participate in at least **1 community service** project (2-3 a semester)
- **Sell 5 during the Fall Fundraiser** for club activities throughout the year
- **Sell 1 bag of beefsticks** (depending on fundraiser) during the Spring Fundraiser for club activities throughout the year

Failure to compile with any of the above may result in the loss of one's ability to compete and show future animal project under the Travis FFA, or received awarded monies. It will also result in removal of contest participation under specified event for the student.
